

## Walter Goessler

Dr. Walter Goessler is associate professor of Analytical Chemistry at the Institute of Chemistry at the University of Graz, Austria since 2003. His research focuses on the development and improvement of analytical methods with emphasis on inorganic analysis. The developed methods answer questions related to human health and our environment. Speciation analysis of nonmetals with element-selective detection (ICPMS/MS) and the biotransformation of arsenic compounds play a central role in his research. Ongoing projects are focusing on trace element accumulation and biotransformation in mushrooms and ultrafine particles in our air.
